Course Description

During their two-year course in Languages, students will develop their Listening, Speaking, Readingand Writing skills in the following Areas of 5 themes, each broken down into topics and sub-topics.

The five themes are:

- Identity and culture;
- Local area, holiday and travel
- School
- Future aspirations, Study and work
- · International and global dimension.

At the end of Year 11, all students will undertake a written, a listening, a reading, and an oral examin the foreign language in an intense one-to-one situation recorded with their teacher. Students might have the opportunity to take part in a language immersion trip to broaden their cultural knowledge as well as their linguistic competences,
