The BRIT School bursary award is available to all BRIT School students from families who are on a low income and/or receive Universal Credit or a benefit as listed on page 3. This also includes young people in local authority care, young people who have recently left care, young people living independently and in receipt of Universal Credit, and disabled young people in receipt of Employment Support Allowance and a PIP (or Disability Living Allowance). The award is Government funded which means that we are required to obtain documentary proof of the household income in order to assess the application.

N.B: If you receive WORKING TAX CREDIT you do not qualify even if you receive child tax credit and your income is below £16,190.00

The BRIT School bursary award amounts to at least £1,260 (KS4) plus discounts, per year and has four

Awards may be withdrawn for any of the following reasons:

- if the student's attendance or punctuality are not acceptable or fall below 90%
- if work set is not completed on time
- if the student's behaviour falls short of the standard required by the School.
