

Post 16 Examination Results 2018

Thursday 16th August 2018

It is a great day for vocational and academic achievement at The BRIT School and once again we are delighted with the students' exam results at Post 16 and feel they reflect their hard work and dedication to their studies. Students commit to a rigorous curriculum specialising in a performing or creative arts vocational qualification and some students also undertake additional A Levels.

All students study for the Edexcel BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma, which is equivalent to 3 A-Levels.

This year 57% of our students achieved the top grade D*D*D*. This is the equivalent of 3 A*s at A level. Over 200 BRIT School students gained this top grade.

79% of our Year 13 students achieved a D*D*D* to D*DD in their vocational qualifications which is the equivalent to an A*-B grade at A Level.

The results once again prove the success of the School. Students are going out in the world with skills, confidence and exceptional qualifications. You can come to The BRIT School and get a head start in your creative and performing arts career and gain brilliant academic results. These are our best ever A-level results. Everything is possible."

Students may also take A Levels alongside their vocational qualification. This year's A Level results are as follows:

A*-A grades	25.58% (16.67% in 2017)
A*- B grades	48.84% (47.37% in 2017)
A*- C grades	83.72% (74.56% in 2017)
A*- E grades	100.00% (98.25% in 2017)

It is noteworthy that our History departments achieved 100% A*-C grades at A Level with 38% of students achieving an A grade. As a result of these achievements the great majority of our students will take up places at top Universities and world-class vocational schools and be significantly prepared for the world of work.

Impressively, eight students have all gained places at Central Saint Martin's to study Fine Art, Textile Design and Graphic Design. As well as four students being accepted onto the Musical Theatre course at ArtsEd including Maya Elliott (pictured below, left).

Interactive Digital Design student Luca Weller-Dawbarn (pictured above, right) achieved D*D*D* with an A in Mathematics. He is now going into a paid internship at CMS Distributions, London.

Max Margolis was our highest achiever studying Music and English Literature. He is now going to study Music at Berkeley, California.

Poppy James, Tara Bhat and Frankie Egan were among our highest achievers all gaining top grades in A-Level History alongside D*D*D* in Dance, Theatre or Visual Art and Design.

Martha Gardner pictured (below) has gained a place at The Royal Conservatoire Antwerp to study Contemporary Dance after achieving D*D*D* in Musical Theatre. This course only accepts sixteen students worldwide.

Over 90% of our Technical Theatre Arts students achieved on or above their target grade.
